



# **Application Process**

The application process for the St. Pete-Clearwater Film Commission (FilmSPC) Incentive Program is designed to be straightforward while ensuring that all necessary information is collected to make informed decisions. Here's a step-by- step guide to the application process:

## **Step 1: Initial Contact**

- Production companies interested in the incentive program should first visit the <u>FilmSPC</u> website to review the program overview and project eligibility details.

## **Step 2: Application Submission**

- Gather and prepare all required supporting documentation, which will include:
  - Detailed project synopsis or final script
  - Proposed project budget and estimated spend in Pinellas County
  - o Pre-Production, Production, and Post-Production schedule
  - List of notable attached ATL and BTL individuals
  - Marketing plan
  - Distribution plan
  - Detailed description of how the project will feature Pinellas County and drive tourism to Pinellas County
  - State of Florida Division of Corporations (Sunbiz) registration

# It is strongly encouraged that you have the above documentation completed before submitting the application form.

- Complete the online application form in full, providing all requested information and including all required document uploads.
- Submit the completed application form.



## **Step 3: Application Review**

- FilmSPC staff will conduct an initial review to ensure the application is complete.
- If any information is missing, the applicant will be notified and asked to provide the additional details.
- Once the application is deemed complete, it will be forwarded to the review committee.

#### **Step 4: Committee Review**

- A committee consisting of FilmSPC and VSPC staff will review the application, assessing:
  - The project's eligibility for the base incentive
  - The project's suitability for uplift incentives
  - o The committee may request additional information or clarification if needed.

#### **Step 5: Decision and Notification**

- The committee will make a recommendation on both the base incentive and any uplift incentives.
- FilmSPC will notify the applicant of the recommendation, typically within 30 days of receiving a complete application.
- If recommended, the notification will include:
  - The recommended base incentive percentage Any recommended uplift incentive percentages and their conditions
  - o The maximum potential incentive payout amount (in dollars)

## **Important Notes:**

- The application process is competitive, and submission of an application does not guarantee approval.
- Incentive payments are subject to availability of funds, agreement to County contract terms, and adherence to all program requirements.
- All information submitted in the application and throughout the process must be accurate and truthful.
- Production Company understands that all correspondence with VSPC and FilmSPC, and all records related to the incentive payments, are subject to the Florida Sunshine law.
- Production Company must maintain related records and documentation for at least three (3) years following the expiration of the agreement.
- FilmSPC reserves the right to deny applications for projects that do not align with the program's goals at its sole discretion.
